## Trisha Smith named home horticultural aide for Piscataquis County

DOVER-FOXCROFT – Dover-Foxcroft native Trisha Smith has been named a University of Maine Cooperative Extension home horticultural aide for Piscataquis County. Smith will coordinate the Master Gardener Program and answer horticultural gardeners' questions in collaboration with Extension educator Donna Coffin.

Smith is a graduate of Foxcroft Academy and the University of Maine. A Maine Master Floral Designer, Smith worked at Riverside Florist in Dover-Foxcroft for 16 years. She also has worked on several farms in the county: Checkerberry Farm in Parkman, and Ripley Farm and Leaves and Blooms Greenhouse in Dover-Foxcroft.

Smith volunteers with Dover Cove Farmers' Market, Dover-Foxcroft Downowners and Center Theatre.

"I am excited about my new position as Home Horticulture Aide

for Cooperative Extension in Piscataquis County, and am looking forward to many opportunities to connect with people and learn about their gardening experiences," Smith said

Smith will work with trained Master Gardener volunteers to develop and manage their projects throughout the year, including expanding use of raised bed gardens, and work with the county and towns on community landscaping efforts.

She also will present gardening classes on such topics as starting seeds, vegetables and flower gardening techniques. In addition, Smith will respond to gardening questions by phone (207.564.3301; 800.287.1491), email (trisha.smith1@maine.edu) or in person at the county Extension office, County Courthouse Complex, Dover-Foxcroft, 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Monday, Thursday and Friday.

Gardeners can bring samples of their garden pests (insects, disease or weeds) to be identified, and to learn what can be done to

manage them in vegetable gardens and the home landscape.

"Trisha's community connections and gardening expertise will be a huge asset to assure great horticulture programming efforts for the people in Piscataquis County," said Coffin. "We are fortunate to have her join the team."

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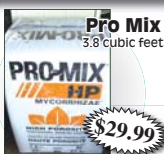

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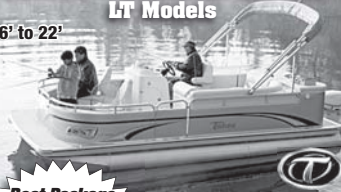

of the cleanest lakes in Maine, if not in all of New England.

But now the Lake faces a threat unlike any other...invasive plant species, such as Eurasian Milfoil and Hydrilla. These plants can take over the lake, destroying habitat, severely limiting access and ruining the resource many count on to provide their livelihood. These plants have arrived in Maine from other states, hitching a ride on any item that may have been in infested waters, from boats, PVCs and canoes to smaller items...water skis, wakeboards and aqua shoes. Belgrade Lakes, a mere two hour drive from Sebec, is now infested with milfoil, believed to have been brought in on a duck decoy! Per Roberta Hill, Invasive Species Program Director, Maine Volunteer Lake Monitoring group, "You can't really cure a lake once it is infested. Remediation takes tons of money and many, many years. The best defense for any lake is a good offense, and that means having a team in place to monitor the lake, and educate its users to those threats, and how to prevent infestation."

In late 2013, a training session was held for SLA members to learn how to identify these species, and to understand how they migrate from an infested lake to a pristine one. Early last summer, SLA began an education effort to raise awareness of this threat. At the 2014 SLA annual meeting, an initiative was

proposed to intensify the Association's effort to protect the lake. That initiative has three components: community education; creation of a lake monitoring program; and establishment of a "rapid response plan" if one of these species is discovered. The Sebec Lake Invasive Plant Patrol was established. "The importance of this initiative can't be understated," said Brian Woodworth, President of SLA. "The future health of the lake we love is at stake here. Milfoil is essentially on our doorstep. We need to act, and we are. Rudy Davis (fellow board member) has done a great job pulling this together, but we can't do this alone. We need dedicated volunteers."

This spring, SLA reached out to the Foxcroft Academy to determine if there would be interest among faculty and students to collaborate with SLA in this effort. The response from Academy leadership was immediate, and clear: YES. "This is a great project, a very important one. As a camp owner on the lake, I am personally very interested in its success. Count us in," said Arnold Shroy, headmaster at the Academy. Per Brian Krause of the science / math department at the academy, "After Rudy reached out to us, many of our students have volunteered to join this effort. They're excited to help protect the lake, and extend their classroom education to the real world. It's a great opportunity for them to give back to the community. I'm looking forward to it myself." SLA and Foxcroft

Academy intend this collaboration to be ongoing year after year. "So many of our students enjoy the lake...it's important that we contribute to this effort to protect it," continued Shroy.

The response from the lake community has been good. "We have a good list of volunteers from the membership. Camp owners are donating time, equipment and funds beyond their annual membership dues to the effort," according to Janet Hall, SLA recording secretary. The first organizational meeting for the volunteer team will occur the latter half of June. Initial training, both classroom and field, will occur on June 30 and July 1. Shortly thereafter, the team will be on the water, initiating the effort to create a vegetation map of the lake, and working at public launches to further education. "Mapping the shoreline of Sebec is a big task, and will take several years to complete. However, it's critical we learn what is already growing in Sebec and to confirm what we believe...that we are currently free of invasives," said Davis. No less a task is ongoing education about invasives, and how to prevent accidental entry to the lake. "The education effort is equally as big. We have a good plan that we'll continually update and adjust. That said, we need the cooperation of a lot of people, a lot of businesses, to be successful. We're optimistic...so many people love this lake. I'm expecting most will react as Tim Merrill has...with a 'how can we help?' We're counting on it."

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# What will the Town of St. Albans look like in 10, 15 or 20 years?

ST. ALBANS - St. Albans residents approved a Comprehensive Plan in 1993. In 2014, a Comprehensive Plan Committee was appointed to review and update or rewrite that Plan.

A Comprehensive Plan is both a summary of the current status of many elements in a town and how those elements will change. It also is an opportunity to plan some of those changes to suit the residents. Those elements include population, housing, economy, natural resources, cultural resources, land use, Public facilities and services, health care, transportation and fiscal capacity.

A very important part of this process is seeking and including input from those most affected by these elements, the people who reside in St. Albans. Although the final decision on acceptance of the Plan will be made at a future town meeting, the Comprehensive Plan Committee welcomes and encourages input from seasonal residents of St. Albans.

On July 6, at 6:30 p.m. at the St. Albans Town Hall, the Comprehensive Plan Committee will hold a public meeting, open to all permanent and seasonal residents of St. Albans, to discuss the Comprehensive plan and to receive their comments and sug-

gestions.

The Committee intends to conduct additional public meetings in the future, but the July 6 meeting was scheduled to allow as many seasonal residents to participate as possible.

Beginning in 2014 and continu-

ing into 2015, a survey of St. Albans residents preferences and basic data for the Comprehensive Plan was distributed. Those survey forms are available at the Town Office.

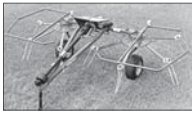

## Dexter business owner testifies before Senate Aging Committee

DEXTER - Senate Aging Committee Chairman Susan Collins recently led a hearing titled, "Work in Retirement: Career Reinventions and the New Retirement Workspace," which was called to examine the opportunities and challenges for seniors who work well into their retirement years—some because they want to and others because they must. At the request of Senator Collins, Susan Nordman, owner of Erda, an artisan handbag company in Dexter testified. Erda employs several seniors.

According to a recent study, nearly half of today's retirees say they either must work or want to work during their retirement years. AARP says that a comfortable retirement now requires a "four-legged stool"—Social Security, a pension, retirement savings, and continued paid work.

Ms. Nordman bought Erda two years ago and began operating it as a second career. She believes that older workers add great value to her small business because of their experience, knowledge, and ability to work in a collaborative environment. These seniors also serve as mentors to younger employees.

Nordman explained that financial necessity dictates the need to work for most of her older workers as retirement is not an option. She dispelled the notion that older workers may be harder to train saying that because of their experience and maturity, older workers tend to embrace new methods more quickly and easily.

Senator Collins said that, for the last century, seniors had been withdrawing from the workforce as Americans came to view retirement as a time of leisure. But the baby boom generation has reversed this trend. In 2000, only 32 percent of Americans age 55 and older were still working. Today, 40 percent of workers 55 and older remain in the workforce, many for financial reasons.

Another witness, Kerry Hannon, who is a columnist and retirement expert, cited a recent AARP study that found that, contrary to common perception, workers age 50 and older do not cost significantly more than younger workers. She cited additional studies that outlined the advantages of hiring older workers which include the fact that these workers have more experience, they have a stronger work ethic, and are more professional.

Witnesses also discussed the need for employers to work to hire, retain and accommodate older workers since they are a growing and vital part of our nation's workforce.

Additional witnesses included; Sara E. Rix, Working and Aging Consultant and former AARP senior strategic policy advisor, and James C. Godwin, Jr., Vice President of Human Resources, Bon Secours Virginia Health System.
