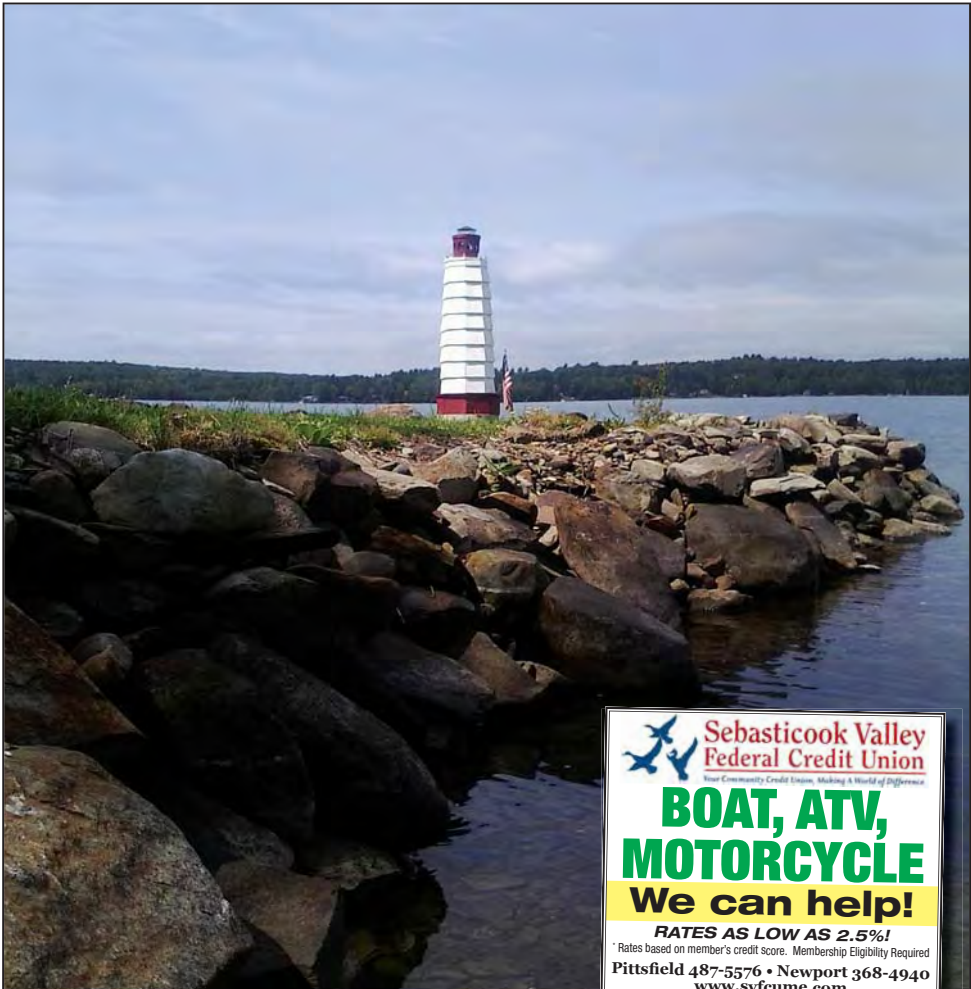

Construction begins on new hiking trails

GREENVILLE - The Maine Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry's (DACF) Bureau of Parks and Lands (BPL) announced that construction work has begun on two hiking trails that eventually will be part of an expanded network of non-motorized trails in the Moosehead Lake Region. The decision to start construction with the Number Four Mountain and Eagle Rock Trails resulted from public input and will be led by the DACF's Maine Conservation Corps.

The one-of-a-kind regional trail development collaboration is made possible through a 121-acre trail easement granted by landowner Plum Creek. Construction by the Maine Conservation Corps began in June, and will likely continue until 2018 in order to complete the entire trail network.

"Outdoor recreation is important to Maine residents and visitors. This public-private partnership will expand outdoor recreational opportunities in the Moosehead Lake Region," said Governor Paul R. LePage. "This project benefits from public input and volunteer support, so I encourage others to become involved."

Commissioner Walt Whitcomb also highlighted the importance of public input and volunteer support. "We were pleased with the public's input that this unique project has received," said Whitcomb. "Citizen input is helping create another gem in Maine's outstanding system of trails and public recreational spaces. The partnership of a major landowner, townspeople and state recreation management experts is a formula for success in this beautiful region of Maine."

Project leader Rex Turner said that the Department and project partners are looking forward to engaging new partners and volunteers for this effort to help support, maintain and promote the trails well into the future. "With these new trails, and others following in the next few years, the Moosehead Lake Region will offer a premier trail network that will be a destination attracting hikers, bikers, skiers and others from far and wide," said Rex Turner, BPL outdoor recreation planner.

An ad-hoc committee led by BPL is coordinating the trail planning effort, and will hold its next informational meeting this fall. Participants and supporters in that effort include citizens from the Moosehead Lake Region and representatives from the Appalachian Mountain Club, Forest Society of Maine, Maine Huts and Trails, the Moosehead Lake Region Chamber of Commerce, the Town of Greenville and Plum Creek. The first two trails to be constructed are:

Number Four Mountain Trail: This project taking place through the summer of 2014, rebuilds and redesigns the current Number Four Mountain Trail. It will reach the remains of the historic fire tower on the mountain and also feature a trailhead parking facility on Plum Creek Mt. Additionally, planning calls for the trail to be expanded southwards from the summit to Lily Bay Mt. and beyond. The current Number Four Mountain Trail remains open to hikers during construction.

Eagle Rock Trail: This new trail will be completed in August and will create 3.7 miles of hiking trail from the Moore Bog area on the BPL's Little Moose Public Land property to Big Moose Mountain's northwest ridge. The trail will culminate at Eagle Rock and feature a trailhead parking facility on Bureau lands.

Planning work under way aims to enable trail construction on portions of Lily Bay Mt. and Baker Mt. in Frenchtown starting as early as this fall. Future trail projects on the 121-acre easement could range from easy walking paths to strenuous backpacking circuits and could accommodate hiking, mountain biking, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, canoe/kayak portaging and wildlife observation activities.

In addition to the land easement from Plum Creek, the company is providing funding for the trail system as part of its regional land use agreement. Additional trail system support will be sought by BPL and planning partners to help maintain the trail network. That support is anticipated to include stewardship approaches such as adopt-a-trail opportunities and other similar volunteer initiatives.

Six-person trail crews from the Maine Conservation Corps will construct the trails. Volunteers are also encouraged to participate.

The 23rd annual Forest Heritage Days (FHD) returns to Greenville on Friday, August 8 and Saturday, August 9 at Greenville Consolidated School, 130 Pritham Ave.

This free, family-friendly event honors the state's most historic industry and celebrates Maine's woods by combining education and entertainment in a unique way, while maintaining a focus on forestry stewardship and sustainability.

"The forest products industry is a major part of Maine's history, economy and future, and this event is a fun way for Mainers to learn more about the state's working forestland," said Candy Russell, FHD committee member. "We welcome visitors from near and far to join us as we celebrate our forests with a weekend of exciting fun for all ages!"

The main attraction schedule is:
Friday, August 8: Working Forest Bus Tour - 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. (\$15 per person), Colby Woodsmen demonstration - 3 p.m. (free), Woodsmen Supper - 5 p.m. and Sumner McKane's "In the Blood" performance - 7 p.m. (\$10 per person).

Saturday, August 9: "Game of Logging" competition - 10 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. (free), Craft Fair - 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. and "Forest Fire Look-outs of the Moosehead Region" presentation - 7 p.m. (free)

In addition to the main attractions, the event will offer free horse and carriage rides, forestry exhibits, food and beverages and a Log-A-Load for Kids Raffle to benefit local hospitals through the Children's Miracle Network. Guests can enter the raffle to win a four-foot-walced bear and chainsaw.

Abbott Memorial, Dexter Historical summer programs

DEXTER - Dexter's Abbott Memorial Library and the Dexter Historical Society have teamed up to present a number of summer programs. On Thursday July 31 they will have a presentation, "An Evening with the Dexter/Newport Railroad," by Leonard Wallace at the Abbott Museum on Church Street starting with an Open House at 6 PM.

For over a year Leonard has been researching the history of the railroad that came to Dexter in 1868. The coming of the railroad from Newport was a major historic event in the commercial development of the town.

Wallace has created a large model taking up the space of a dining room table. Using over 2 dozen wooden models, he pinpoints the location of the important buildings in the depot. Today there is hardly a trace of this once huge railroad depot that had covered many acres at the corner of Liberty Street and Railroad Ave. Gone is the ticket office, water tower, turntable, train sheds, repair sheds, and cargo warehouses that extended 300 feet in length along Railroad Avenue. Here were stored Dexter's many products, ready to be shipped all around the world.

Molly Graham, Oral Historian and Associate Director of Oral history and Folklore Research at Rutgers University will discuss preserving stories, recollections, and voices of local people and events on Wednesday, August 6. Topics to be covered will be setting up an oral history project, equipment needed, and interviewing skills.

A Cruze-In is scheduled on August 9 in the Dexter Municipal parking lot with food, music, and prizes. The event runs from 5 to 9 p.m. Antique autos and street rods will be exhibited and the Grist Mill Museum will be open throughout the evening. All proceeds go to the historical society.

Wendall Kinney, Maine Humorist, will make a presentation about his growing up on a dairy farm on the Crawford Road on August 22. Now a resident of Brunswick, he has written poetry and a book of short stories. He is presently out with a new CD called, "The Bull And I, Maine Humor with a Twist." All stories he tells are true; but, "with a bit of blarney added for flavor."

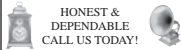

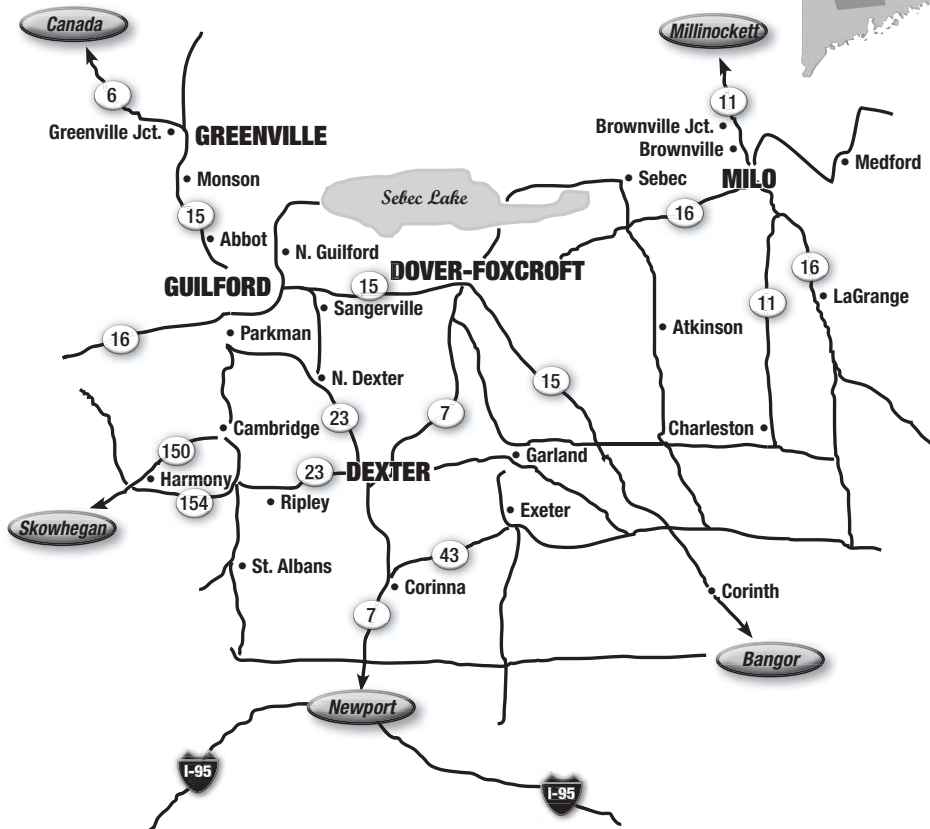
