129th Piscataquis Valley Fair set for August 25-28

DOVER-FOXCROFT - Carnival rides, traditional agricultural exhibits, two slam-bang demolition derbies, tractor pulling and musical entertainment from rock to modern country highlight the 129th edition of the Piscataquis County Fair in Dover-Foxcroft from Aug. 25-28.

Billed as Maine's "Down Home Country Fair" because of its diverse attractions and affordable prices, the four-day show strives to add improvements each year, according to Fair Association President Rusty Weymouth.

"We've brought back the horseshoe tournaments for the first time in 10 years," Weymouth "We've also added new hand-washing stations near the animal exhibits along with the regular hand sanitizers. We hope to educate fair-goers about E. coli bacteria."

While many people think of E. coli as an infection caused by eating undercooked hamburgers or drinking raw milk, state health officials also advise washing your hands after petting farm animals. turns this year with their carnival rides and concessions and Weymouth said that the fair association and patrons "have been very happy with them over the vears.

The highlight of the musical lineup is "Scarab: The Journey Experience," a Boston-based tribute band on stage Friday, Aug. 26 from 8-10 p.m.

Scarab recreates the music of the supergroup of the 1970s and 80s that sold over 47 million albums and also had numerous top-40 hits including "Don't Stop Believing" and "Open Arms."

The Foxcroft Academy Band will be on stage Thursday at 5 p.m., followed by the Tyler Healy Band, the 2016 Pine Tree State Modern Country band award winner, at 8

Another local favorite, country rock band Sharon Hood and Dixon Road, hits the stage on Saturday, Aug. 27 at 7 p.m.

For fans of motorized mayhem,

at 6 p.m., the Tuff Truck competition on Aug. 26 at 6 p.m., truck pulls on Aug. 27 at 6 p.m. and two demolition derbies on the final day of the fair – Sunday, Aug. 28.

The Pro-Modified derby at noon is new this year, Weymouth said, and caters to drivers "who want to build their cars up more than the stock entries." The regular derby will begin at 3 p.m. and all the rules, purses and entry fees will be posted on the fair's web-

For quieter times, the Mad Scientist and Dan Grady's Marvelous Marionettes are back this year. The Mad Scientist, a favorite youngsters' entertainer, will appear twice on Friday and twice on Saturday while Grady's show takes place twice Friday through Sunday. The Mad Scientist will be set up at the gazebo next to the ice cream parlor and Dan Gray's Marvelous Marionettes will be on the hill by the fair office. For the ladies, there's the annual

Smokey's Greatest Shows re- there's a Figure 8 race on Aug. 25 Skillet Throw on Aug. 27 at the horse pulling ring at 11:30 p.m.; and more fun for the youngsters comes with the pig scramble on Sunday at 1 p.m., also at the pulling ring. There's a \$2 entry fee and parental permission slips need to be filled out.

This year's fair program is dedicated to Ralph "Eddie" Lewis of Dover-Foxcroft, who has been a fair association member for more than 30 years (see separate story) and the Farm Family of the Year is the Simpson Farm of Corinna. which has been in the same family since the early 1900s. It's currently owned and operated by Ron and Julie Simpson and their three children: Sarah, Samantha and "R.J."

Simpson Farms has 825 milking cows and 700 young stock and ships over 60,000 pounds of milk daily to Oakhurst Dairy.

2016 Piscataquis Valley Fair dedicated to Eddie Lewis

DOVER-FOXCROFT — When Ralph "Eddie" Lewis found out that he was going to receive a major community service award last December, he was shy about showing up for the event.

Dover-Foxcroft Fire Chief Joe Guyotte joked that it also "took some convincing" to persuade Lewis to wear a tie to the Piscataquis County Economic Development Council annual meeting to receive the Myron "Pete" Myrick award.

But Lewis doesn't have to dress up for his latest honor. This year's Piscataquis Valley Fair has been dedicated to him.

"Eddie is the type of guy who does most of his work behind the scenes," said Fair Association President Rusty Weymouth. "You'll see him weed-whacking, painting, moving stuff around – anything that needs to be done to spruce the fairgrounds up."

Lewis, who served on the Dover-Foxcroft Fire Department for 46 years, also takes care of the fire extinguishers at the fairgrounds.

In addition to his volunteer work at the Piscataquis County Fair, he also helps with many Dover-Foxcroft Kiwanis Club ac-



Lewis graduated from Dexter High School in 1962, served in the military until 1969 and went to work for Guilford Industries after his discharge.


Lewis later worked for Judkin's Shop 'N Save – now Will's Shop 'N Save – for over 20 years taking care of the frozen food and produce aisles.
